Our Guiding Principles:

- All work is done by club members. Jump in and get your hands dirty. However, in addition to planting, we also need members to actively participate in a wide range of related activities (i.e., fundraising, social events, IT support) during the year. There's a way for everyone to contribute.
- We plant communally and share in the harvest. When harvesting, the rule of thumb is "take what your family needs for dinner tonight."
- Children are always welcome if accompanied by an adult club member.
- Pets are never allowed in the gardens.
- Members cannot plant anything in the gardens, or amend the soil in any way, without prior club approval.
